

Doping controls – Requirements for the organizer

Facilities

As the organizer, you are responsible for the arrangements and furnishing of the control station. This includes the waiting area for the athletes, the control area, and the toilets for sample collection. Here, you can find two examples for control facilities.

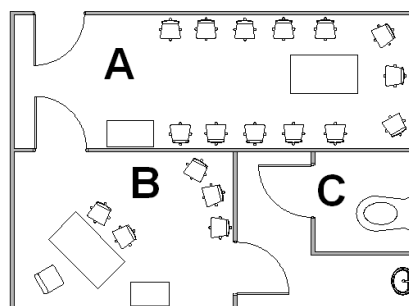
Waiting Area (A): The waiting room should be large enough to accommodate at least four athletes including their support personnel. The waiting room should be equipped with:

- sufficient seating,
- waste containers,
- original sealed drinks of medium size in sufficient quantity.

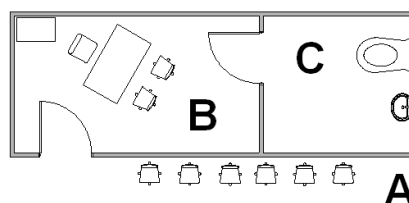
Control Area (B): In the testing room, the doping control is carried out (except the provision of the urine sample). The room must be lockable and not visible from the outside. It must be equipped with:

- 1 table,
- 4 chairs,
- 1 large waist container.

Lavatory (C): A separate toilet with washing facilities must be connected to the control area for the provision of the urine sample. The toilet should provide sufficient space for the doping control officer to observe the provision of the urine sample without obstruction.

Chaperone

Athletes must be under constant observation by a so-called chaperone from the time they are called up for doping control until its end. It is your responsibility as the organizer to provide the chaperones (and interpreters if necessary) for the doping controls. In principle, one chaperone per athlete to be tested must be expected.

Persons used as chaperons must be of legal age and of the same gender as the athlete to be supervised.

For reasons of credibility, it should also be ensured that the persons in question have no personal relationship to the athlete to be supervised.

Accreditations

Doping control officers and chaperones must be provided with appropriate accreditations that give them access to all areas of the competition site and allow them to perform their duties without hindrance.
